





In lesson features include:


- **Draw** Enables a Draw Tool with different colors and sizes that the teacher or students can use to draw on the screen.
- **Text** Allows the teacher or student to put a text box on the screen. This is sometimes used to translate the text to another language or to put a teacher note on the screen.
- Widgets Allows the teacher to place a Timer, a Keyboard, a Metronome, or a Soundboard over the screen.
- **Video** Plays a teacher-recorded video for the student if the lesson is sent home as an assignment. The video is recorded in the Resource Creation screens component.
- Worksheets Allows the teacher to access all the printable worksheets in the lesson and print them as desired.
- **Link** Puts a QR code on the screen that can be scanned by students to load the screen on their device as well as a text link that can be copied and sent to students.
